The Installation Dinner on January 7<sup>th</sup> was a great event. I'd like to thank Bill McCombs for chairing this event, held at The Club at Picatinny. Thanks also to Helaina Semmler for once again running the always entertaining gift exchange. Although she lost her voice towards the end, everyone enjoyed the give and sometimes take. The best part of the evening, however, was that we got to give money to our designated charities from our two shows of 2022. We were honored to have *Semi*-Hemi John P. from Nielsen Dodge as well as Dorothy R., Portia B. & Shirley R. from Sister2Sister in attendance. In total, we donated \$4,250 from our show proceeds to The NJ Fireman's Home, Mount Pleasant Animal Shelter, Sister2Sister and Brick City Rescue. You should all be proud of that, especially those of you who volunteered at the shows.

Speaking of shows, there a major change in our calendar for this year. We will not be running the Spring Roundup show at Nielsen Dodge in 2023. We have finally lined up a Ford dealer that is going to support us, both physically & financially, in hosting an All-Ford show. Performance Ford has agreed to host/sponsor a show at their dealership on Rt. 10 in Randolph. Many of you who have been in the club for a while may remember this location as Trebour Ford, the site of the GSRMC's shows in the early days of the club. I find it fitting that we return there 30 years after our first show.

While we hope to iron out the details in the coming days, the plan is for a June show that will have the familiar favorite forty format. In the past we were able to fit about 150 cars in the tiered parking lots, so for a first-year effort,

it should be an ideal location. However, many of you may have noticed the brand-new Ford dealership going up on Rt. 10 in Whippany, about midway between our old meeting hall & Nielsen Dodge. The goal is to have our show at this state-of-the-art facility as early as 2024. That site would enable us to turn that show into one of the biggest Ford



shows in the area. We are also in talks with them about staging a Grand Opening display in the coming months.

Nielsen Dodge has been a great partner for us, and we will once again be hosting our Autoberfest show there on October 1<sup>st</sup>. We are hoping to continue to grow that show into a major event on the region's car show calendar and they are all-in on the idea. If you have ideas on making that event better, please contact me sooner rather than later. I hope to have flyers for both shows done ASAP.

Before those shows happen, there is the club's National Mustang Day celebration scheduled for April 15<sup>th</sup>. As we saw last year, the benefits of having it on a weekend are too hard to pass up. I probably don't need to remind any of you who were there that well over 100 Mustangs showed up at Performance Ford in East Hanover that morning. While that was a great day, we would like to see if we can up our game a little. The locations, destinations and details have not been set yet, but the one thing that won't change is extending the invitation to all Mustang enthusiasts. We probably had about 30-40 non-members join us last year and within the following weeks, we had converted at least half of them to members. Again, if you have any suggestions regarding this event, please contact me ASAP.

Besides those three major events we will be celebrating the club's  $30^{\text{th}}$  anniversary starting at the March meeting. That's only two months away! I would like to work the anniversary into many of our events, particularly the All-Ford show. The meeting, however, will be the kickoff.

That list doesn't even include parades, the picnic, a probable event at Brook Hollow winery etc., etc., etc. Maybe, we can get back to monthly Club Cruise Nights or a rallye or a tour. We are only limited by time and you. I'm referring to you individually and you, collectively.
